Flash Fundamentals CS3

Course Description

Adobe® Flash® CS3 Fundamentals is an introductory course that provides designers and developers new to the Flash environment the knowledge and hands-on practice they need to create rich Flash content. Students will produce an engaging interface using text, graphics, animations, video, and sound. Simple user interactions are added using built in ActionScript behaviors and Script Assist. The class will provide hands-on exercises to reinforce concepts and skills introduced in the class.

- Use and understand the Flash tools
- Use and understand workspace layouts and panels
- Select and edit objects
- Use Flash templates
- Create text blocks and convert them into shapes
- Work with layers, including the mask layer
